- To work alongside other club coaches.
- To ensure all activities are conducted in accordance with the Club's Health & Safety and Child Protection policies.
- To help develop positive behaviours related to the growth of our young people.
- To provide feedback to the Director of Hockey on progress.

Performance

- To help develop individuals within a team context.
- To drive positive social cultures within our teams.
- To utilise the club's performance analysis tools to offer high levels of feedback.
- To make talent ID related recommendations.

Qualifications / Requirements

- Minimum Level 1 hockey coaching qualification is desirable.
- A sound technical knowledge.
- An understanding of principles and how that relates to technical and tactical delivery.
- Ability to plan and organise session that engage both low and high ability.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality.
- Commitment to safeguarding children and young people.
- Commitment to continuous professional development.
- Willingness to commit to the Club's aims and values.
- Commitment to equity, diversity and inclusion and understanding how this applies to the role.
